The Center of Socio-Political Data (CDSP)

- A *Réseau Quetelet* partner, the **French portal for data in humanities and social sciences**
- The CDSP disseminates <DDI-C> documented surveys since 2005
- Data Producer since 2012 (ELIPSS panel)
- About 220 data files **documented and made available to the scientifically interested public**

Responsible for distributing socio-political data

- Survey data on **political attitudes and value systems** in France
- Online access to **national and local elections** results from 1965 to 2012
- Access to **large-scale international** studies for Sciences Po researchers




